

Welcome to the Messenger as we enter 2019. This will be a busy time in school and we look forward to the exciting events planned.

<u>Safety First</u> - Just before Christmas we had a new electronic entry system installed in school. This insures no unauthorized access to the school building. Keeping our pupils safe is of paramount importance! It has been noted that vehicles driven by parents from St. Patrick's College, have been using our staff carpark as a turning circle, especially after school. Just before Christmas, one P7 pupil was almost hit by such a vehicle at the gate after PAL Club. To avoid a reoccurrence and to ensure our children are safe when in the front playground, in future the carpark gates will be closed at break, lunchtime and after school. Should anyone need to avail of the handicapped parking space in the staff carpark at pick-up time, this will still be available. It is the responsibility of anyone using the staff carpark for this purpose to ensure the gate is closed again when they leave. Please ensure the entrance to the staff carpark is kept clear to enable staff to access the park in the mornings.

<u>Change of Teacher Training Day</u> - Due to the confirmation that there will be a Council Election on Thursday 2^{nd} May, it has been decided to move our Teacher training day from Monday 10^{th} June to Friday 3^{rd} May. This means that pupils will be off school on Thursday 2nd, Friday 3rd and Monday 6^{th} May. This is to avoid us returning after Easter to be at school for three days, off Thursday, back Friday and off again on Monday!
